"Temporary Evidence of Lawful Admission for Permanent Residence"; or Visa in an unexpired foreign passport with a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) stamp and the statement "Upon endorsement serves as a temporary I-551 evidencing permanent residence for 1 year"; or U.S. Travel Document (form I-571) with stamp "Permit to Reenter."
<input type="checkbox"/> Refugee	Electronic I-94 showing "RE" as the class of admission and "DS" as the "admit until" date or paper Form I-94 or I-94A with a date that has not expired. The I-94 may include the endorsement "209a/209b pending. Employment Authorized."

<input type="checkbox"/> Person paroled into the U.S. for at least one year	Must provide evidence (such as having filed an Application to Register Permanent Residence of Adjust Status via Form I-485 or being named alien relative from a petitioner via form I-130 that they are in the U.S. for other than a temporary purpose and intend to become a citizen or permanent resident. Must provide documentation of parole status via an I-94 form indicating that you have been paroled into the U.S. for at least one year, with a date that has not expired.
<input type="checkbox"/> Victim of human trafficking or spouse, child or parent of	Victim must submit certification or eligibility letter from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). Spouse, child or parent of victim must submit a copy of the victim's certification letter and a copy of their T-visa.
<input type="checkbox"/> Battered immigrants	I-797 form showing a class of U or a court order from an immigration judge confirming your status.
INELIGIBLE CATEGORIES	Applicants for permanent resident status who have none of the above documentation; or Persons with only a non-immigrant visa; or Persons with only an employment authorization
