The Regents' Overnight Host Program (ROHP) is a student-run program within the Regents' and Chancellor's Scholars Association, an organization for current recipients of the most prestigious scholarship at the University of California, Berkeley. Each year, the ROHP Committee holds six two-part, overnight programs for candidates of the Regents' and Chancellor's Scholarship, to provide them with a true sense of what it is like to be a Regents' Scholar at Berkeley. Prospective Scholars will [virtually] have the chance to:



- **Experience** — Experience Berkeley's campus culture and learn more about the benefits of the prestigious scholarship
- **Interact** — Meet with other highly-accomplished students from all over the country, mingle with current scholars, listen to keynote faculty speakers, and view student performances
- **Discover** — Embark on virtual tours, including majors-focused tours and our world-famous nighttime campus tour

As coordinators of the Regents' Overnight Host Program (ROHP), we would like to formally invite you to attend one of our six virtual overnight programs held for high school students nominated for the Regents' and Chancellor's Scholarship. We are a student-run program within the Regents' and Chancellor's Scholars Association, an organization for current recipients of the most prestigious scholarship at Cal. Our goal is to assist you and other scholarship candidates in making the best decision when choosing where to attend college.



The mission of ROHP is to provide you with a true sense of what it is like to be a Regents' and Chancellor's Scholar at Berkeley. Throughout the program, students will be able to learn about Berkeley's campus culture, learn more about the benefits of this prestigious scholarship, network with current Regents' scholars, speak to highly-esteemed faculty speakers, meet other highly-accomplished students from all over the country, receive advice on how to get through their Regents' interview, and embark on virtual tours including our world-famous nighttime campus tour. There are six overnight programs you can choose from to attend. There is a capacity limit for each program and spots are given to those who sign up first. Due to the global pandemic, all six programs will be held virtually over Zoom. **Each of these programs are split into two parts: a night portion and a morning portion.** The night program will start at 4:30 PM PST and end at 10:00 PM PST (with breaks and optional activities in between); the morning program will start at 9:30 AM PST and end at 1:30 PM PST (with breaks and optional activities in between as well):

1. Program 1: Friday, February 26th - Saturday, February 27th
2. Program 2: Friday, March 12th - Saturday, March 13th
3. Program 3: Saturday, March 13th - Sunday, March 14th
4. Program 4: Friday, March 19th - Saturday, March 20th
5. Program 5: Saturday, March 20th - Sunday, March 21st
6. Program 6: Friday, April 16th - Saturday, April 17th (This program is for students who receive the scholarship after their interview.)

We do not provide additional programming for parents during the night portion of the programs; however, they are welcome to join the students during the morning portion of the programs at 9:30 AM PST for our majors-focused tours and other activities.

Our programs are very popular amongst students and space is limited; spots are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. **If you would like to attend and participate in ROHP, it is important that you [sign up through our website](#) (<https://rohp.berkeley.edu>) by completing one of the Typeforms listed under**

each date as soon as you can. Please sign up for only one night. If the date that you'd like to attend is full, there is a separate Typeform that you will need to complete to place yourself on the waitlist. (If you would like to be on the waitlist for multiple dates, you will need to refill the waitlist form for each date you are interested in).

Five days before the program date you've signed up for, you will receive an email that will include the name of your host (a current Regents' Scholar) and a Zoom link that you will use to attend the official program at 4:30 PM PST.

This program is entirely student-run and free of charge. Because these programs will be held on Zoom, you may need to download the free Zoom software at <https://zoom.us/download> and **create a free Zoom account** before you register for a program date. Be sure to constantly check our website and social media pages for updates on our program. We will be posting committee member spotlights, answering frequently asked questions, holding Instagram Live Q&As, and posting the behind-the-scenes planning of our programs on all social media platforms throughout the months of February, March, and April.

If you are already curious about the breadth of experiences and interests at Berkeley, feel free to scroll through each ROHP committee member's biography on our website. Our committee is incredibly helpful, passionate, and ready to answer any general questions you may have about UC Berkeley, the Scholarship, or the college experience.

If you have any further questions, feel free to contact us via email or social media. Because we are also full-time students, it may take us about 1-2 days to get back to some of your questions and emails. We hope you decide to attend this amazing program that convinced us to attend UC Berkeley when we were in your shoes!
